We are again offering the same system, and would encourage as many walkers as possible to use this method. Using 'Just Giving'

'Just Giving' is a fantastic way to increase the amount of money you raise for your charity as it allows you to reach family, friends and work colleagues at home and abroad via their email addresses, and, you don't have to collect the cash after you've walked as 'Just Giving' does that for you!!

How do I use 'Just Giving'?

You will need to "Make your Page" with Just Giving - click here - [Romsey Test Trust Fund Just Giving Page](#). Then:

- Click the "Make Your Page" link, then under "Get Started" click the blue "Make Your Page" button
- Then fill in your details and click "Create Account"
- On the next page chose the "An Organised Event" option.
- Search "all events" for the word "Testway" and then choose the "Rotary Club of Romsey Test - WALK THE TEST WAY" event.
- On the next page enter a suitable web address, ensure that you indicate that "My charity is not contributing" and then click the blue "Make your page" button.
- Follow the instructions for "Making your page" not forgetting to enter details of the charity you are supporting.
- email you page link to your friends, family, etc.

NB: If you already have an account with Just Giving and are going to add another page, make sure you log on to "Romsey Test Trust Fund" as the charity and then the organised event will be "Rotary Club of Romsey Test - WALK THE TESTWAY", as above.
