

Walk Terms and Conditions 2022

Dated: Wednesday 20th April 2022

COVID 19:

The Rotary Club are closely monitoring government advice on the COVID19 situation and will update this as the government guidelines change.

If the government restrictions change which cause the event to be cancelled, or a walker must isolate due to a positive test, then the affected participants will have their registration fee donated to their charity.

Registration:

The registration fee is payable at the time of registration and is non-refundable (except the COVID note above).

Walkers under 18 must be registered by their parent / guardian. Team/Group leaders should get parents/guardians to register their children separately after registering themselves and a team name.

Under 16 walkers must be accompanied on the walk by an adult approved by the parents/guardians.

On the walk:

"Marathon" walkers should be able to finish in 9 hours, an average of at least 3mph.

Walkers arriving at Parsonage Farm after 1700hrs should note that for safety reasons they must take transport provided to the Romsey Memorial Park for medal presentation.

Walkers must follow the directions of walk marshals and must not leave the signposted and marshalled route without notifying a marshal.

If unable to continue or need medical assistance, walkers should advise the nearest marshal, who can call for medical assistance or evacuation.

If walking with a dog ensure it is on a short lead at all times particularly where contact with livestock is possible.

Photos will be taken of walkers and may be used for event publicity in a variety of media.

Sponsorship:

All fundraising by walkers must be done for their chosen charity through the charity 'Rotary Club of Romsey Test Trust Fund'.

Walkers will each aim to raise Sponsorship (we suggest a minimum of £50) in support of their nominated charity either by:

1. Online using JustGiving, specifying "Rotary Club of Romsey Test Trust Fund" in support of the "Walk the Test Way".
2. Use sponsorship sheets and agree to collect the sponsorship money and forward it together with the completed sheets to the Rotary Club's Walk Treasurer within 3 weeks after the walk.

The Rotary Club of Romsey Test will where appropriate claim back Gift Aid from HMRC and add to their sponsorship.

Rotary will pay the walker's nominated charity 80% of their sponsorship if raised through JustGiving or, 75% if raised by sponsorship sheets or other donations. The balance will be used by Rotary for Rotary charitable purposes.
