Registration £16 (£9 for under 18) Payable in advance



The route is fully marshalled, patrolled and signposted at key points. There are toilets on the route also.

Fitness Requirements

The course marshals all have mobile phones and we have medical assistance on-site in the unlikely event of an emergency.

Restrictions
